He graduated from Midwest City High School in 1972 and attended Rose State College.

After school he joined local union 798. He served 40 years as a pipeline welder and fabricator building oil and gas pipelines and offshore drilling rigs across the U.S. and Canada. Keith was a Native American Indian and a Citizen of the Chickasaw Tribe and was a very proud father of eight children.

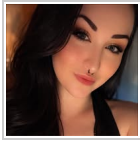
