Ben Wiggins Jr. was born July 15, 1929 in Conroe, Texas to Ben Sr. and Mary (Gandy) Wiggins. On February 12, 2017 at his home, Ben went home to be with his Lord and Savior at the age of 87 years, 6 months and 28 days.

Ben came to Bryan Co. in 1977 from San Antonio and graduated from Conroe High School. He proudly served his country in the United States Air Force and reached the rank of Master Sergeant before retiring after 20 years of faithful service. Ben received the National Defense Medal, Air Force Medal, Air Force Good Conduct Medal with 10 oak leaf clusters, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with 10 oak leaf clusters, Air Force Commendation Medal with 10 oak leaf clusters, and the Small Arms Expert Marksmanship Ribbon. During his Military career, Ben was responsible for medical evaluations for the astronauts of the Mercury 7 that included; John Glenn, Allen Shepard, Scott Carpenter, Gordon Cooper, Wally Schirra and Deke Slayton. He also answered the Lord's call and graduated from seminary school to become a Minister. Ben would go on to minister at the First Baptist Church of Bennington and was always known to care for and help the members. He enjoyed fishing, reading, fishing and fishing. Ben also enjoyed working in the garden and doing medical research from time to time, but most of all he enjoyed spending time with his grand and great grand children. He will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
