Benjiman Richard Taylor (Benny) 86 of Achille Ok passed peacefully into Heaven's Glory on June 1, 2018.

The funeral service will be held at 1pm Monday, June 4, 2018 at Brown's Funeral Service Chapel Durant in Oklahoma. Pastor Michael Moody of First Baptist Church Yuba will be officiating. He was a direct descendant of the Colbert and Kemp Chickasaw families. He started working as a young man helping his Great Uncle John Grinslade in the dairy business in Childress Texas. He was drafted into the military where he proudly served in the US Army, After his honorable discharge he lived in Fort Worth, TX and worked for a hide company. He moved his family back to Achille, OK where he was employed by Hale Trailers and became a farmer and rancher. He also owned and operated his own bulldozing service and built many ponds in and around Bryan County. He was the builder and owner of the Achille Funeral Home. My dad was the hardest working man that ever lived. If you

knew him you know he often worked past the sunup to sundown timeline, up until he had to retire for health reasons. Benny loved playing dominoes, fishing, and spending time with family.
