When asked weeks before her passing what dreams she had growing up, she said she wanted to be a mother and grandmother and raise children. There wasn't a friend, neighbor, or probably mailman that came by that didn't hear about her "beautiful" children and grandchildren. She had a devoted love for her brother, Jimmy, and sister, Sherry, who all had a strong bond with one another growing up.

Aside from her main job she loved as being a mother, she worked for many years starting at a young age picking cotton. A few notable places she worked at were Stromberg Carlson, followed by the refinery, and her last job as managing the Highland Park apartments in Ardmore.

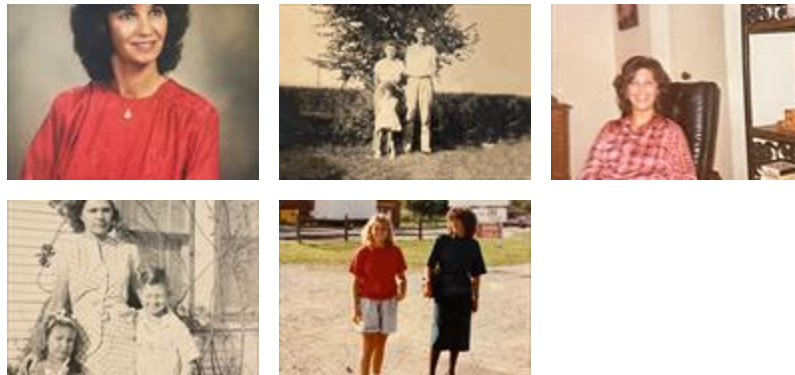
