Billy Roland Glover was born on April 27, 1929 in Arkadelphia, Arkansas to Willie Ross and Leasea (Sheets) Glover and passed away on April 30, 2014 in Durant, Oklahoma at the age of 85 years and 3 days.

Billy proudly served his country in the United States Navy serving in World War II and the Korean War until his Honorable Discharge. Billy was known as the “Candy Man”. He was a member of the Gurdon Arkansas Lodge #187 of the Free and Accepted Masons and the VFW. He enjoyed fishing, being a handyman, gardening, golf and riding lawnmowers.
