Billy James Goins II was born Sunday, July 8, 1962 in Santa Maria, California to Rev. Billy James Goins Sr. and Janis Annette (Alsup) Goins. Billy passed from this life on Monday, August 9, 2021 in Denison, Texas at the age of 59.

Billy married Monica McGee on February 2, 1997 in Corona, California. They came to Bryan County in 2017 from Hemet, California.

Billy grew up in his hometown of Lone Pine, California. Billy furthered his education at Vanguard University, Oklahoma University, UC Riverside, Cal State University San Bernardino, AMU and KTC Auto Mechanics School. He was a Teacher, Behavioral Support Specialist, Counselor, Basketball Coach, Interim Principal, Grant Writer, and helped start three Military Charter Schools.

Major Goins is an accomplished soldier serving in the United States military. His dedicated service began with the United States Navy in June 1985 and continued with the Navy Reserves for several years. Billy enjoyed cooking with his family and friends. He was a mentor to many people he came in contact with and would help anyone in need. Billy spent numerous hours researching his ancestry and lineage. He loved the outdoors where he spent a lot of time fishing and hunting. Billy's joy was spending time with his loving family.
