



Bobby Ralph Harris

Bobby Ralph Harris, 84, of Mead, OK, passed away on December 17, 2016. Born on October 3, 1932 to Jack O. Harris and Elizabeth Bolin of Jimtown, he attended high school in Leon, OK before entering the United States Army in 1952.

That year he married Lillie Mae Roach of Burneyville, OK. His daughter Tina Lynn was born in 1954 and his son Dale Ray was born in 1956. After his Army service, Bobby and family relocated to El Paso, TX where he worked at the White Sands Missile Range.

In 1970, Bobby became owner and proprietor of the El Rancho Motel in Fort Stockton, TX and a third child, Ben, was born in 1972. The family relocated to Wilson, OK in 1980 before moving to Mead in 1985. As the owner and operator of the Six Oaks Motel and General Store in Mead and later Bob's Lake Country Motel in Kingston, he enjoyed over two decades of serving locals and visitors to Lake Texoma. After retiring, Bobby indulged in some favorite pastimes: his dog Blackie, Sooners and Cowboys football, Rangers baseball, and his pipe. He was a life-long Baptist.

Bobby is survived by his wife, two sons, and four grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his mother and father, his brothers Ray and Jack Jr., and his daughter Tina.
