Bennington, OK- Bonnie Marie (Andrews) Mize was born Saturday, February 9th, 1929 in Bennington, Oklahoma to Samuel Alexander Andrews and Ella Mae (Cross) Andrews. Bonnie was reunited with her husband, James (Buddy) Mize, on Sunday, June 11th, 2023 from her home in Bennington at the age of 94.

Bonnie grew up in Bennington and attended Smith-Lee and Bennington schools. She married James Calvin (Buddy) Mize on September 1st, 1951 in Durant, Oklahoma. He preceded her in death on July 16, 2006. Together, they lived in Irving, Texas where she worked as a bookkeeper at a furniture company. They would always come home to Bennington on weekends and enjoy the peace of country life. Bonnie would later be employed at Texas Instruments in Sherman for four years. She returned to college earning her teaching certificate and taught for a few years until her retirement. They moved to Sherman in 1968 and in 1972, moved to Bennington where she spent her last years.

Bonnie enjoyed crafts, oil painting artwork, sewing and making quilts, and making homemade dolls with clothes. She had a gift of making her own clothes as well as her family's. Bonnie was of the Pentecostal faith. She enjoyed going to church, singing, and listening to gospel songs.
