Bonzie Groce Harris was born March 1, 1913 in Carvers, Cumberland County, Kentucky, to Charlie Baker Groce and Alice Kathryn Ferguson. Bonzie went home to be with her Lord and Savior on April 18, 2013 at the age of 100 years, 1 month, and 17 days.

Bonzie married Levie Cleo Harris on October 30, 1939. In 1942 Bonzie left Kentucky and moved to the farm near Randlett and Walters, Oklahoma until moving to Skellytown, Texas in 1947. Bonzie has lived in the Lake Texoma area since the year 2000. Bonzie loved flowers and was always gardening, and will be remembered for her beautiful Christmas decorations she would put up every year at her home.

Bonzie was preceded by her husband Levie in 2005; parents Charlie and Alice; brothers Curtis Edward Groce, William Travis Groce, Pitts Groce; and sister Sally Minnie Groce Thrasher.
