It is with great sadness we announce the death of Bradley Craig Johnson on January 25, 2025. Bradley's life began in Dallas, Tx on January 13, 1986 to Roger and Karen Johnson who had always wanted a son after having two daughters, Janette and Angela.

Bradley was born into the Choctaw tribe of Oklahoma, where he was raised on a farm in Caney Oklahoma. At age 11, his baby sister, Liddy, was born. He was finally a big brother. Their relationship was one of a kind. From two small children bantering with each other to two grown adults protecting each other. The last three years they lived together spending their nights laughing, talking, and listening to music.

Bradley was born fearless, which stayed with him throughout his life. He loved life and lived it to the fullest, spending time hunting, camping, riding dirt bikes and motorcycles. From a young boy, he was strong-willed with a tremendous work ethic. His interests were never ending, yearning for the knowledge of anything he could get his hands on, and for Bradley he was great at so many things. After graduating from Caney High School, he went on to accomplish many trades, including welding and horseshoeing. He spent most of his adult career in the Natural Gas industry working as a General Foreman.

Bradley may claim his sisters are the social butterflies of the family, however

the impact this young man made on others was magical to watch. His ear-to-ear smile, his southern drawl, and his contagious laugh would make a stranger feel like his best friend. He was rough around the edges, but his soul was beautiful and pure. As he walked into a room, moving from person to person you could see the brightness radiating off him.

At the age of 21 Bradley fell in love for the first time when he held his first-born son, Aidan, in his arms. Later he met the love of his life, Gina, and loved her until his last day. He helped her raise her two sons, Jayden and Jaystin, they then had his second born son, Tripp. Bradley was a proud father who had unwavering love for all his sons. They followed in his footsteps, playing basketball, baseball, riding horses, and bull riding. He loved watching them grow into the young men they are today.

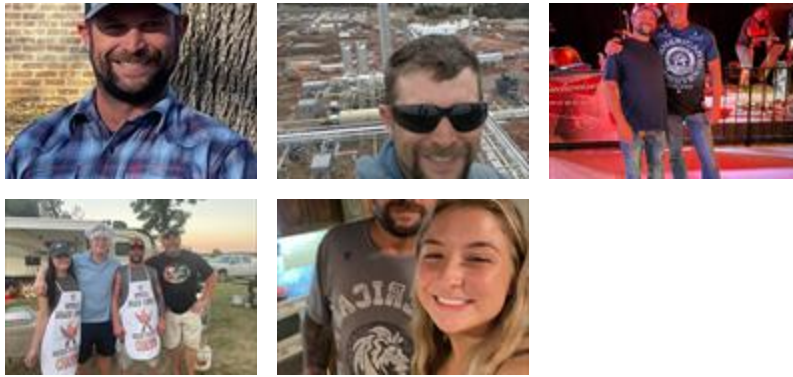
