Carl Wayne Phillips passed away on November 22, 2020 in Denison, Texas at age of 75. Carl was born on February 8, 1945 in Bokchito to Ollie “Bob” and Lavern (Raines) Phillips.

Carl graduated from Bokchito High School and attended Okmulgee Tech. He married Mary Annabeth Albright on April 3, 1965 in Calera.
