Carol Virginia (Martin) Weaver was born on December 25, 1923 in Drumright, OK the second child of James Martin and Frances (Dearing) Martin and passed from this life on Monday, June 20, 2011 at the age of 87 years, 5 months and 26 days. She attended and graduated from Drumright Public School and then was employed at Stanolind Oil and Gas in Tulsa, OK as an assembler before the war. She joined the United States Navy on November 14, 1944 and was honorably discharged on July 16, 1946. While serving in the Navy she was assigned as Telegrapher First Class and she received the American Theatre and Victory Medals. After the war she married James Marshall Weaver and to this union were born three children. She graduated from Oklahoma A & M in Stillwater in 1949 and Carol and her family moved to Durant the summer of 1949. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church in Durant and later was a member of Victory Life Church in Durant. She was an accomplished pianist and played the piano for the East Side Presbyterian Church in Durant for a number of years. Carol dearly loved playing with her grandchildren and deeply loved her Lord and Savior.
