Rev. Charles W. Loyd entered this life on May 31, 1934 in Roberta, Oklahoma born to Sparland William and Ola Irene (Boatner) Loyd. Charles entered the Gates of Heaven on January 23, 2021 in Fort Worth, Texas at the age of 86.

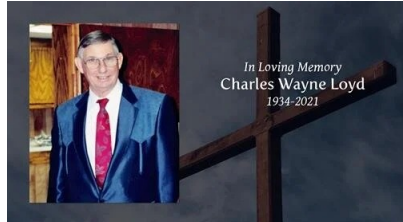
