



Charlie Glenn Marlow

June 6, 1918 - February 19, 2010

Charlie Glenn Marlow was born June 6, 1918 in Bokchito to Charlie Houston Marlow and Minnie Belle (Thompson) Marlow and passed from this life Friday, February 19, 2010 in Plano, Texas. Glenn is a lifelong resident of Bokchito. He married his first wife Dorothy "Dot" (Winters) on December 13, 1946 in California, she precedes him in death. He married two more times, the second marriage to Mary Robinson, then later to Marie Nowell. They also precede him in death. Glenn is a retired carpenter who enjoyed building things with his hands. He was a devout Christian who enjoyed going to church and loved being with his family and friends. He also loved horses and caring for them. Glenn proudly served our grateful nation in the U.S. Army during World War II. He was awarded two purple hearts in 1943 for wounds received in action during World War II. He also received two bronze service stars and one oak leaf cluster. Glenn was honorably discharged from the service in June 1945 as

a Sergeant. He will be greatly missed by his family and many good friends.

Glenn is preceded in death by his parents, brothers Roy, Jack, and C.H. Marlow; sons-in-law Bobby Albright, C.J. Anderson, and Sam Taylor; a granddaughter Misti Albright; a stepdaughter Joan Miller; and stepson David Nowell.
