



## Conway Edwin Harper

January 20, 1921 - November 27, 2009

Conway (Curly) Edwin Harper was born in Durant to Luther and Hattie (Drum) Harper on January 20, 1921. He passed from this life on November 27, 2009 after a brief illness. Conway graduated from Cobb High School in 1939. He enlisted in the National Guard (45th Div, 180th Inf.) in 1940. Upon his honorable discharge in 1943, he went to Ypsilanti, Michigan and began working for Ford Motor Company. There he met Elizabeth (Beth) Stevens and they were married November 30, 1945 in Newburg Michigan. He retired from Ford Motor Company in 1975 and they moved to Silo, where they continued to live. He was a member of the Durant First United Methodist Church.
