Danny Lynn Comer, 78, of Mead, OK, passed away Tuesday, July 26, 2011, at Four Seasons Nursing Center in Durant, OK. He was born December 12, 1932 in Detroit, Michigan, and attended schools in Memphis, Tennessee; Kansas City, Kansas; Rawson, Ohio; and Mt. Cory, Ohio. He earned a Bachelor of Science and a Master of Arts, both in Industrial Arts from the University of Northern Colorado in Greeley, Colorado. He served in the United States Air Force for four years during the Korean Conflict. After serving he became a teacher in the Jefferson County Schools in Denver, Colorado for 18 years. He then went on to run a family owned business in Midwest Spring and Chassis for five years before moving to Durant, Oklahoma to begin ranching in 1983.

Dan married Marilyn Murphree in 1957 in Denver, Colorado and together they raised three children in Golden, Colorado. They were married for 54 years.
