David was raised in Tishomingo, he attended Tishomingo schools and later received his GED. He co-owned Walker Septic Tanks and worked for OG&E. He met and married Clarissa Peden and they made their home in the area. He then became a technician for the Oklahoma Department Wildlife Conservation where he worked for over 27 years. He was an inventor with two patents pending and had built several houses in the area. He could build, make, or fix

anything. He was very passionate about his worship at Victory Life Tabernacle in Durant where he had been a member since 2001. He was a valued usher, was a member of the singles group and had been a member of a Care Group.

Survivors include a daughter, Alisha Deann Key and a son Brian Walker of Tishomingo, and a stepdaughter, Stephanie Broughton of Duncan. A sister and brother-in-law Sharon and Ronnie West, a sister-in-law Oma Dell Walker, a daughter-in-law Delilah Walker all of Tishomingo. Grandchildren include John and Aaron Key of Duncan, Jeremiah, Elijah, and Alexis Broughton, Ashlee, Baylee, and Brilee Walker all of Tishomingo and Sheylon Broughton of Duncan.
