



Dawson "Sonny" Walker

July 19, 1929 - August 21, 2015

Dawson Walker, age 86, a longtime resident of Tishomingo passed away August 21, 2015 in Ardmore, Oklahoma. He was born on July 19, 1929 to Waldo and Nora (Holly) Walker in Emet, Oklahoma. He married Lajoy (Deaton) Walker in 1982 at Allen, Texas and she preceded him in death on April 24, 2010. He attended school in Nida, Oklahoma.
