Dean Bivens Swiney was born on February 6, 1927 in Fort Worth, Texas to John Luther and Jessie (Ward) Swiney and passed from this life on Sunday, June 19, 2016 in Denison, Texas at the age of 89 years, 4 months and 13 days.

After graduating high school, Dean entered the United States Navy and later served in the United States Air Force until his retirement on August 31, 1966. Dean served his country in World War II, Korea and Vietnam and received AFLSA: with 3 Br OLC and NDSM: with 1 Br Silver Star along with several other commendations. Dean later graduated from Southeastern Oklahoma State University with his bachelor's degree with Honors. He and his loving wife of 66 years, Billie Jean owned and operated Red Wing Pest Control in Durant for 20 years until their retirement. Dean was a member of the Bokchito Masonic Lodge #19.

Dean was preceded in death by his parents; son, Russell Swiney and brothers, Leslie and Bruce Swiney.
