August 19, 1926 - February 9, 2015

Dillon Lee Jones passed away on Monday, February 9, 2015 in Denison, Texas at the age of 88 years, 5 months and 21 days. Dillon was born on August 19, 1926 in Calera, Oklahoma to Paul Dillon and Rosa Lee (Guess) Jones.

Dillon attended school to the ninth grade then went to work on the family farm. On May 9, 1945, Dillon entered the United States Army and was deployed to Japan on October 25, 1945 serving in World War II. Dillon was honorably discharged on December 23, 1946 and later worked for Bell Helicopter and Boeing Aircraft as a sheet metal mechanic until his retirement. He was a member of the Park Avenue Church of Christ, American Legion and he enjoyed fishing, dancing at the Sherman Senior Citizens and playing dominoes at the Broughton Senior Citizens where he was Senior of the Month in December.
