



## Doyle Elton Jestis

March 17, 1935 - December 31, 2015

Doyle Elton Jestis, age 80, died on December 30, 2105 at Texoma Medical Center.

Mr. Jestis is survived by a son, Steven, his grandson's Brandon and Shane, and a daughter-in-law Patricia. He is also survived by brothers Karl Dee Jestis, Dwight David Jimmy Jestis, Olen Jestis, and numerous nieces, nephews, and extended family members. He was preceded in death by wife Shirley Faye Jestis, parents Horace Elton Jestis and Mary Lucille Jestis, and brother Danny Lee Jestis.

Doyle was a proud veteran, serving in the Korean War, the Vietnam War, and was assigned overseas duty for eleven years. He served as a United States Marine from 1953 to 1956 where he reached the rank of Sergeant, and in the United States Air Force from 1958 to 1975 where he reached the rank of Technical Sergeant in the dual carrier fields of communications and jet engines. He received three commendation medals while serving his country. He was later certified as 100% disabled veteran resulting from his service. Doyle grew up in Bryan County. As child he, along with his brothers, helped

his parents on the family farming and ranching operation. His attention to detail was legendary. The discipline and patriotism he learned in the Marines never left him, as friends and family will attest.
