Louise Curtis was born on Wednesday, May 18, 1921 in Nashville, Tennessee to A.S. and Edna Lavender Gardner. She grew up in Nashville and graduated from East High School in 1939. On June 10, 1942, she married Lincoln Hill Curtis, to whom she was a good wife. For a period of time she worked at Bell Telephone in Nashville. Her immediate family was her pride and joy. She kept enough memorabilia on them to write their complete history. She was a faithful member of the Lord's church, most recently as a member of the 7th and Beech Church of Christ in Durant, OK. She was a quiet lady, but influenced many by her dedication to the Lord and His church and by her generous spirit to missions. She passed from this life on Friday, October 8, 2010 at her home in Durant.

She was preceded in death by her parents, A.S. and Edna Gardner and brother; her brother, Leslie Gardner; one son, Lincoln Harold Curtis on July 17, 1952 and her husband of 55 years, Lincoln Curtis on December 13, 1997.
