Eula Lee (Ingram) Parker passed from this life on Thursday, November 13, 2014 in Durant, Oklahoma at the age of 95 years, 8 months and 8 days. Eula was born on March 5, 1919 in Caney, Oklahoma to Walter B. and Emmie (Jenkins) Ingram.
