



Floyd Ray Amos Jr.

August 30, 1930 - September 14, 2014

Floyd Ray Amos Jr. was born on August 30, 1930 in Gunter, Texas to Floyd Ray Sr. and Vesta (Chaffin) Amos and passed from this life on September 14, 2014 in North Richland Hills, Texas at the age of 84 years old.

Upon graduating, Ray joined the United States Army and proudly served his country during the Korean War. He married Olive Mozella Tucker on June 18, 1951 in Calera, OK and they were later blessed with a daughter, Roselee. On July 10, 1953 Ray was honorably discharged from the military and went to work as an engineer for LTV. After Ray's retirement from LTV, he and Mozella moved to Mead, Oklahoma. Ray and Mozella were members of the Emmanuel Baptist Church. He enjoyed racing dune buggies, woodworking, gardening, and fishing.

Ray was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, William Floyd.

Ray is survived by his loving wife of 63 years, Mozella Amos; daughter, Roselee Kerr; grandson, Johnny Ray Kerr; sisters, Marita Campbell, Shirley Toney and husband Fred, Janie Groce and husband John, and Brenda White and Jeff Peterman; brother, Charley Amos and wife Nancy; and sister-in-law Abilene Amos.
