Floyd H. Buchanan of Tuskahoma, OK. passed away on Thursday, November 30th, 2017 in Caddo, OK. at the age of 69. He was born in Garland, TX. to Fred Hendrix Buchanan and Mable Leola Marlow Buchanan on August 15th, 1948.

Floyd lived most of his life between Oklahoma and Texas but was lovingly known as a “gypsy” that never settled in one place too long. He served his country in The United States Marine Corps, was a light weight Marine Corps Boxer and was a member of the American Legion. Floyd was a loyal and hardworking “jack of all trades” that could solve problems and fix anything in the blink of an eye.
