Frank Taylor Cross, age 78, passed away peacefully with his wife Winona of 54 years by his side, on May 6, 2025. Frank was born on January 5, 1947, to Clyde and Mary Cross in Waurika, Oklahoma. He graduated from Ringling High School in 1965. He also earned two bachelor's degrees from Southeastern Oklahoma State University: one in education and the other in electrical engineering. On August 12, 1971, he married the love of his life Winona Faye (Bennett) Cross.

Frank proudly served in the United States Navy, including a year in Vietnam. He served aboard the USS Eisenhower and the USS Wasp. He worked in the oil industry for many years and ultimately found his calling in drafting and facility engineering. Frank was the VP of facilities of Indian Nation Wholesale until his retirement. He was a member of Kemp Baptist Church. Frank lived his life devoted to his family. Of all of his accomplishments and titles in life, his roles of Husband, Father, and Grandfather were his proudest. 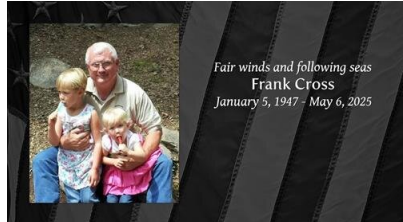

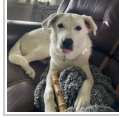
