He returned to the electrical field in Durant from 2001-2012 in Durant, Ok. As his health declined, he retired to work in the family business and be with his family. Throughout his career, he was known for his hard work, dedication, and passion for helping others. More than anything, George was a devoted father and grandfather. He loved spending time with his children and grandchildren, sharing stories, playing games, and watching their favorite TV shows. He was always there to offer guidance, support, and encouragement, no matter what challenges they faced. He was patient and compassionate and showed love to his family and anyone near him. In his free time, George enjoyed grilling for company and his family, throwing horseshoes, river trips, NASCAR, Street Outlaws and, listening to rock'n'roll and country music LOUD.
