



## Gerald Lee Phillip Wilcox

January 19, 1971 - February 19, 2017

Gerald Lee Phillip Wilcox was born on January 19, 1971, in Oklahoma City, OK to Ronnie Wilcox and Sharon (Sanderson) Wilcox. He passed from this life on February 19, 2017 in Plano, Texas at the age of 46 years and one month.

Gerald attended elementary school in Durant and Caddo and later, in 1989, graduated from Silo High School. After graduation he moved to Las Vegas where he worked as a Carpenter's Apprentice, a Teamster, a manager at Dolly's Café and at Bally's Casino as a Sports Writer. To support his work at Bally's he completed bartending school. Gerald used his earnings from Las Vegas to pursue his dream and attend the Los Angeles Film School where he completed an Associate's Degree in Cinematography in 2010.

In his spare time Gerald enjoyed playing golf, fishing, cooking and making his large family feel loved. Gerald's death was sudden and his family mourns deeply but he continues to help others and their families by being an organ donor.

Gerald is survived by his grandmother Corinne Sanderson of El Sobrante, CA, his mother, Sharon Wilcox of Durant, OK, and his father, Ronnie Wilcox of Red Oak, OK.

Growing up, Gerald was the youngest of nine children. He had seven older sisters and one older brother watching out for him. To all of this extended family, Gerald showed the love that only a young uncle can.
