Glen Melvin Jackson was born on February 26, 1922 in Princeton, Texas to Thomas G. and Dora F. (Singleton) Jackson and passed from this life on June 30, 2016 at the Oklahoma Veterans Center in Ardmore at the age of 94.

At the age of 19, Glen enlisted in the United States Army and served in World War II and Korea. He spent 29 months in combat. On October 11, 1952 he was Honorably Discharged. Glen married Roma Lou Gardner and they have been truly blessed with 69 years of marriage. Glen worked as a foreman for a bridge construction company and the Oklahoma Dept. of Transportation until his retirement. He was a proud member of the VFW and he enjoyed drinking coffee with friends at the café, making fishing nets and was very prideful of his long stem roses. Glen will be greatly missed by his family and many friends.
