Glenda Sue Schammerhorn entered this life at 7 a.m. November 13, 1949 in Shawnee Oklahoma, born to William Robert Campbell and Billee Joe Campbell.

She went to be with her Lord and Savior on Saturday, March 27, 2021 about 1:30 p.m. at the age of 70 years, 4 months, and 14 days.

At the age of 15, Glenda was saved at the Falls Creek Baptist center while attending a youth retreat. She attended school at Bethel Acres, Oklahoma, graduating in 1968. She attended college at Murray State College for two years and Southeastern Oklahoma University where she graduated with a B. S. in Home Economics on May 26, 1972. In 1975 Glenda and Jim joined Calvary Baptist Church in Tishomingo and served faithfully for many years. They had their first child, James E. III, on May 19, 1983. During the summers Glenda and Jim would stay at their cabin in Tin Cup, Colorado enjoying the fellowship of many friends and family that came to visit each year. She learned to really enjoy tent camping and Jeeping the high country. She was thrilled to have company, especially her grandchildren. She loved spending time with the grandkids and teaching them her favorite hobbies, including, card making, coloring, and wood burning.

Glenda was the second oldest of eight children with three sisters, Francis, Janis and Joy, and four brothers, Robert, David, Richard, and Ernie.
