Glynda Jane Herndon (Brown), of Durant, OK passed peacefully to eternal rest on January 16, 2025 in Tyler, TX at the age of 84. Born on August 6, 1940 in Brownsville, OK to Arthur Edgar Brown and Annie Laura (Goff), Glynda graduated from Kingston High School and married Ferrell M. Herndon on August 2, 1958. Together, they spent 45 loving years in marriage and raised their daughter, Stacy Chambers. Glynda worked as a Receptionist for the Art Department at Southeastern Oklahoma State University for many years and was a longtime member of the Bryan County Federation of Democratic Women, as well as the Bryan County Genealogy Library and Archives. When not spending time with friends and family, Glynda enjoyed her time as a passionate and venerable amateur genealogist and historian—she deeply appreciated Oklahoma and American history— and also loved to sew. Her life is marked by a quiet, yet immeasurable, depth of compassion and selflessness toward her family, friends, and all she encountered. She has left an indelible mark on everyone she knew, and a fire for good that will never go out.

Glynda was preceded in death by her parents, her loving husband of 45 years, Ferrell M. Herndon, sister Neva Clark, and brothers-in-law Emit Clark, Jackie Pilgrim, and Jack Cumbie. 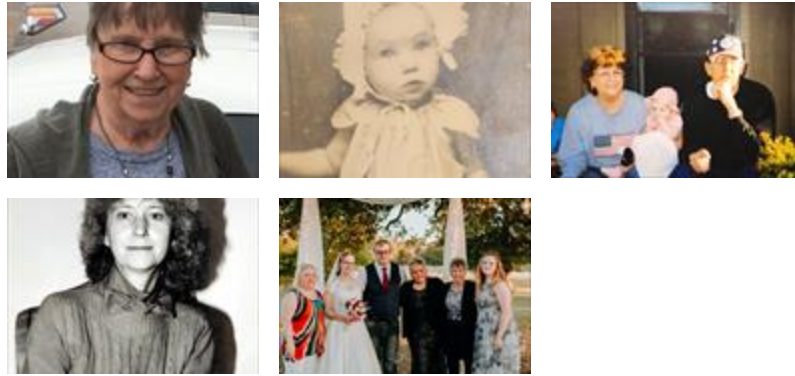
