



Hellen Estell Isenberg

November 7, 1919 - May 1, 2024

Hellen Estell (Jennings) Isenberg was born on November 7, 1919, in Nida, Oklahoma to Thomas Homer and Lula Florence (Leach) Jennings. Estell was blessed with 104 beautiful years and entered the arms of her Lord and Savior on May 1, 2024. She was a Christian woman who devoted her life to her family. She married Hershel Lee Isenberg on December 21, 1935, in Duncan, Oklahoma. Estell enjoyed sewing, quilting, cooking, reading, and babies. Despite raising 9 children, she would babysit for others even into her 90's. She is preceded in death by her parents Homer and Florence Jennings and her husband Hershel Lee Isenberg. Two sons: Chuck Isenberg and Jimmie Isenberg, also one great-grandson and two great-granddaughters.

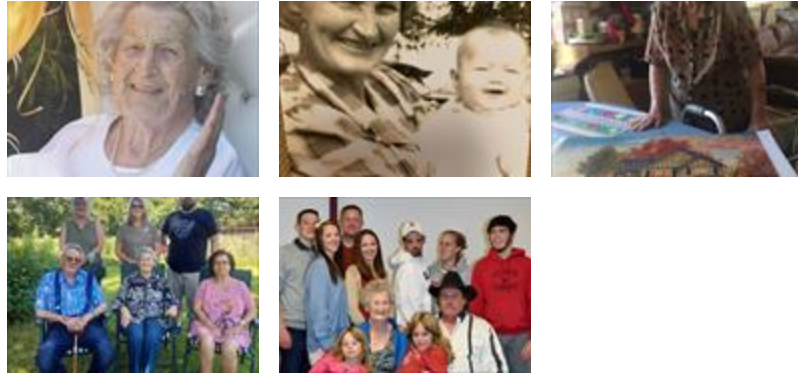
