Odessa Irene (Chalk) Moore, 93, passed from this life, Tuesday, July 15th, 2025 at her home in Durant, Oklahoma. Irene was born on Sunday, October 25th, 1931 at Achille, Oklahoma to Russell C. Chalk and Ethel May Sparks Chalk.

Worthy Matron many times. She is a member of the First Baptist Church of Durant. She loves her Sunday School Family dearly. She loved attending church services, and special activities especially with her Sunday School friends at the First Baptist Church. She also enjoyed the First United Bank Chairman's Club activities with her friends.
