He graduated from Shawnee High School and continued his education by receiving Bachelor's Degree from Central State College and his Master's and Doctorate Degrees from Oklahoma State University. He proudly served his Country in the United States Navy serving in WW11. He married Roberta Howe in Van Buren, Arkansas and they were blessed with 4 sons. He taught school in Blackwell, Ok and was the assistant football coach and the head basketball and baseball coach from 1959 to 1964 and then taught school at Grant County Schools from 1964 to 1966.
