James Wayne Workman, 74, of Caney, Oklahoma, passed away on September 11, 2017 in Denison, Texas.

Family night will be 7 pm Thursday, September 14th at Brown's Funeral Home in Durant, Oklahoma.

Funeral services will be held 1 pm, Friday September 15th at Brown's Funeral Home in Durant, with the Charles Sammy Howard officiating.

Wayne was born in Caney, Oklahoma to Jennings Wagoner and Lora Workman on May 1, 1943. He went to school at Caney until graduation in 1961. He married Susan Rose on April 6, 1965 in Caney. They were married for 15 years. He later married Carol Stokes on January 24, 1984 in Atoka. They were married for 20 years.
