November 4, 1918 - January 17, 2012

Jim W. Cline was born on Monday, November 4, 1918 in Summerfield, Oklahoma to Rosco Delbert and Lizzie Bell (Lay) and passed away on Tuesday, January 17, 2012 in Durant, Oklahoma at the age of 93 years, 2 months and 13 days. Jim entered the United States Army on October 17, 1941 and served his country in World War II earning a Bronze Star and several other medals and accommodations and was Honorably Discharged on December 9, 1945. Jim married Leva Alene Hatter on January 14, 1949 in Denison, TX and they moved with their family to Bryan County in 1971 from Talihina, OK. Jim was a mechanic for most of his life and later owned a grocery store in Mead for three years. Jim was of the Assembly of God Faith and he enjoyed gardening, fishing and going to auctions.
