



## Jimmy Everett Gibbs

August 24, 1946 - February 3, 2015

Jimmy Everett Gibbs, 68, passed away Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at OU Medical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma after suffering a stroke on January 28, 2015. Jim was born on August 24, 1946 in Durant, Oklahoma. He graduated from Madill High School in 1965 and enlisted in the United States Navy in 1966. After serving 4 years as a signalman during the Vietnam War he was honorably discharged in 1970. In 1981 he met and married Janice Marie McDuff in Birmingham, Alabama. Jim was passionate about antiques and owned Yesterday's Antiques for 12 years. He was also an avid rock hunter and collector and a champion of stray cats. Pursuant to Jim's wishes a public viewing of his body was held on Thursday, February 5 from 1-8 PM and Friday, February 6 from 8:30 AM-4 PM at Brown's Funeral Home in Madill. Also a private family hour was held Friday evening February 6 at Brown's Funeral Home.
