



Joe Glenn Dill

July 21, 1936 - October 22, 2011

Joe Glenn Dill entered this life on July 21, 1936 in Bennington, OK born to Clint Dill and Bertha (Labor) Dill. He passed from this life on Saturday, October 22, 2011 at the age of 75 years, 3 months and 1 day. Joe lived in Bryan County (Bennington/Bokchito area) until entering the U.S. Navy where he served his country in the Sea Bees for 5 years. As a young man, Joe loved to fish and hunt; but later in life, he spent most of his time caring for his family, home and animals. He married his wife, Shelby (Campbell) Dill on December 24, 1955 in Bokchito, OK. After serving his country, he and his family settled in Garland, TX where he worked and retired from U.S. Steel. Like most parents and grandparents, Joe's girls and grandchildren were the limelight of his life. In February 2005, Joe and Shelby left their home in Texas and move back to Oklahoma.

Joe was preceded in death by his brother, Carl Dill, who died in the Korean War; and his mother, Bertha Labor Dill.
