Johnny Wayne Shalver entered into eternal rest on Tuesday, April 14, 2015 in Durant, Oklahoma at the age of 66 years, 7 months and 14 days. Johnny was born on August 31, 1948 in Amherst, Texas to John Russell and Leona (Wages) Shalver.

After graduating from high school, Johnny proudly served his country in the United States Army Airborne Rangers. He served two tours during the Vietnam Conflict as a medic and was Honorably Discharged. Johnny married Kathy Allen on December 23, 1969 in Pauls Valley and they were blessed with three children. They moved to Bryan County in 1997 and he retired from Weyerhaeuser as an industrial medic after 20 years of service.
