Kristin Lynn Lumley was born in Yakima, WA on November 18, 1974. She left her physical body, surrounded by family, on January 30, 2025, at Medical City Hospital in Dallas, Texas. Kristin, and her daughter Sierra, moved from Yakima, WA to Pottsboro, TX in 2015 where Kristin accepted a position with the Choctaw Nation. Over the past ten years, Kristin devoted much of her time and energy to helping the Choctaw Nation thrive and in return they made her dream come true, honoring her with the position of Executive Officer of Gaming and Hospitality. Kristin was always telling stories about “her guys” and deeply loved her Choctaw family.

As successful and accomplished as Kristin was at work, she was most proud of her role as mother to her beautiful, compassionate, intelligent, strong daughter, Sierra. Kristin and Sierra spent 27 beautiful years together, navigating this world through joy-filled times (like traveling to Europe or playing countless hours of board games). Kristin was the happiest when she was in nature, with those she loved. So much so, she was a founding member of the F-n-A Hiking Club. Some of her favorite hikes included Goat Butte Mountain, Bear Creek Mountain, and anything over 10 miles because one can only assume she enjoyed watching us struggle.

Kristin is preceded in death by her grandmother, Viola Lumley; grandfather, Baptist Lumley; grandmother Jessie Schaefer; grandfather Ken Schaefer; her

best friend and cousin Michelle Porter; her soul-dog Pheobo, and several other relatives and friends that she loved very deeply.
