Lee Paul Renfro of Durant passed away on Saturday, March 24, 2012 in Durant at the age of 40. Lee was born December 22, 1971 in Tishomingo, OK to James "Buster" Renfro and Margaret Laverne (Ables) Renfro. He graduated from Coleman High School then worked as a painter for Sundowner. Lee was a member of the Hopewell Baptist Church and a member of the Sipokni West Gun Fighting Reenactment Club where he was elected Vice President. He married Lacey Nicole Zachry on May 16, 2009 at Fort Washita.

He is preceded in death by his son Braden Renfro.

Lee is survived by his wife Lacey of the home, one daughter Brittany Renfro of Durant, his parents Buster and Margaret Renfro of Kenefic, OK, two brothers Jerry Renfro and wife Glenda of Coleman and Steve Renfro and wife Jill of Sulphur, OK and numerous friends and family.
