Edward Lee Wood, age 69, passed from this life on Thursday, June 19, 2025, in Sherman, Texas. He was born on March 27, 1956, in Stillwater, Oklahoma, to his parents, Hubbard L. Wood Jr. and Catherine "Cat" Wood. Lee moved to Durant in 1969 from Scott Air Force Base in Belleville, Illinois, and made it his lifelong home.
