Marshall Oliver Cathey Sr., age 82, of Sherman, Texas, passed from this life on Monday, June 9th, 2025 at Texoma Christian Care Center in Wichita Falls, Texas, Wichita County, Texas. Marshall was born on Wednesday, December 2nd, 1942, in Encino, New Mexico to Bill Oliver and Flora Leona (Hyde) Cathey.

He attended schools at Boggy Depot, Tushka, and graduated from Bokchito High School in 1958. He attended Southeastern Oklahoma State University before enlisting in the U. S. Army where he served for two years at Fort Huachuca in Arizona.

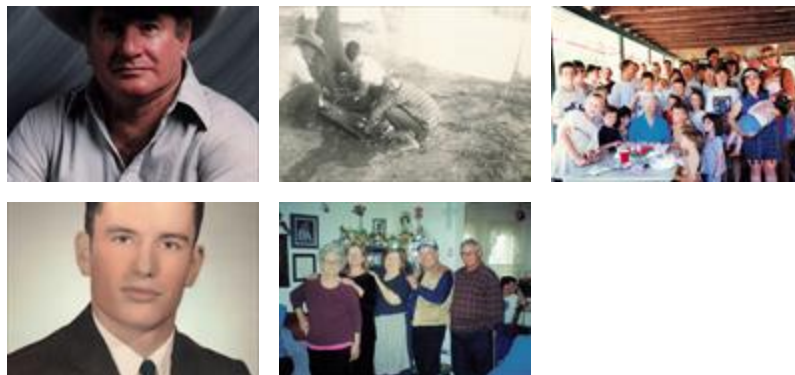
