Mary Lou (Pittman) Parris went to sleep in death on September 26, 2015 at the Oakridge Nursing Center, here in Durant, OK. She was a beautiful woman spiritually and physically. She was born in Bennington, OK on August 16, 1927 to Maggie Pistubbee and Frank Pittman, who are both deceased. Mary Lou attended school at Carter Seminary Indian School for girls at Ardmore, OK, Chilacco Indian School at Chilacco, OK up north Newkirk, OK. After moving to San Angeles, TX she met and married Carl Parris by whom they had three children, Frankie Summers who took care of her at her home since she was bed- fast until Frankie was contracted with cancer and died of a heart attack August 3, 2015 and buried on August 5, 2015. Then she was moved to Oakridge until her death. Mary Lou began serving Jehovah God in 1952 and had faithfully served him over 60 years influencing other relatives to serve him. She lost many loved ones in death over the years and took comfort in the hope of the resurrection when she will be reunited with Paradise here on earth.
