Chief Master Sargent Lennis D. Yates, Retired, passed away on Saturday, November 2, 2013 at his home surrounded by his family, at the age of 87 years, 5 months and 15 days.

Lennis was born on May 18, 1926 in Utica, Oklahoma to Rea Daniel and Gladys Bessie (Griffin) Yates. Lennis proudly served his country in the United States Air Force, serving in World War II, Korea and Vietnam. Lennis was honorably discharged on February 28, 1975 after 32 years of service. Lennis married Nima Mae Billy on October 20, 1947. In 1997 he married Louise Conditt. Lennis was a member of the Elks Lodge, VFW and was a big supporter of Boys Town, Oklahoma Highway Patrol, and the Texas State Trooper Association.
