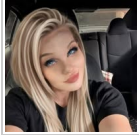

Matt stopped the car at the bridge, and he looked down at the riverbank, and was silent for a moment, as if he was remembering a memory. Matt said, "My dad used to take me fishing here when I was a kid. " Then, without a word being spoken between us, he drove across the bridge and turned the car around, and we went to my house. When we arrived at my house, I could tell our day out was taking a toll on Matt. He was tired and his body was in pain. He sat in the recliner, and his coughing gradually increased, and his moaning from the pain got louder and louder. I made him an oriental stir-fry. We ate. He ate it all and was able to hold it down without throwing it up, which was a happy surprise, because the last
