Mona Jo Cumbie of Russett, OK passed away on Wednesday, November 19, 2025 in Durant, OK at the age of 90 years old. She was born on July 28, 1935 in Brownsville, OK to Arthur Edgar and Annie Laura (Goff) Brown, known as "Aus and Slack".

Mona Jo attended Russett Schools and graduated in 1953. She met her high school sweetheart Jack Edwin Cumbie while attending high school.
