Wanda Murldeen Walters was born November 9, 1933 to Ollie Irvin and Sarah Malveria Boyd in Eunice, New Mexico. She entered rest April 23, 2026 at the age of 92.

Murldeen was raised on the family ranch about five miles south of Eunice. She attended Eunice Public Schools where she played in the band and various sports, and received her high school diploma.

She married Paul Emery Leon Walters April 5, 1953. The couple had 3 children Delvin, Dallan and Cara. In 1966 she and her family moved to Enid, Oklahoma to be a caregiver to her mother and father-in-law. In 1970 the family moved to Bromide, Oklahoma and worked on various ranches. In 1977 the family moved to Coleman where she drove a school bus for 13 years. When Delvin opened a boot and saddle shop in 1984 she helped him by making belts, billfolds, purses and various leather items. In 2004 she retired and resided in Coleman, followed by a short time in Calera Manor nursing home in Calera, Oklahoma where she passed away.

She was a God-fearing woman and lifelong member of the Church of Christ.

She is survived by her son Delvin Walters and wife Jan of Coleman, Oklahoma, son Dallan Walters and wife Barbara of Stillwater, Oklahoma, son-

in-law Jason Stafford and wife Julie of Caddo, Oklahoma; six grandchildren, fourteen great grandchildren and sisters in law; Lois Morgan, Rita Boyd and Connie Mullins.

She is preceded in death by her parents, all six of her siblings, husband Leon Walters, daughter Cara Stafford, and grandson Garrett Walters.

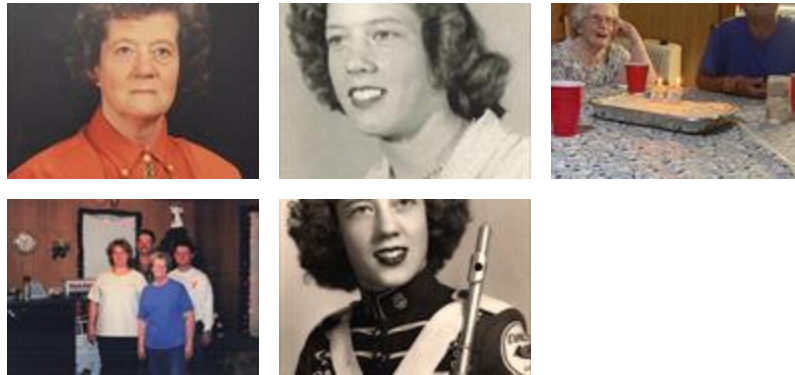
