Nancy Gail (Hendricks) Miller died Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at her home with her family by her side.

Nancy was born to Curley and Glenna (Gentry) Hendricks on October 12, 1939 in Anna, Texas.

Nancy married Bill Miller on June 14, 1958 in Anna, Teas. They moved to Coalgate, Oklahoma in 1961 and lived there until they moved to Caddo, Oklahoma in 1963. Nancy and Bill both worked at the Bryan County National Bank, then at Shamrock Bank in Caddo until their retirement. Nancy retired in 2006.
