Mrs. Omega Virginia (Baldwin) Kerr of Mead, OK went to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on October 25, 2009 at Texoma Medical Center in Denison, TX. Samuel Kerr and Virginia Baldwin were united in Holy Matrimony on July 21, 1951 and were happily married for 51 years. Virginia (Ginny) was preceded by her beloved husband Sam on September 26, 2002, her parents, William Jess Baldwin and Grace Mae (Johnson) Baldwin, two brothers, three sisters and several nieces and nephews.

Virginia was born May 24, 1931 at Newstate, OK and graduated from McAlester High School in 1949 and won a McAlester beauty pageant that same year, being named "Miss Komar". She traveled from coast to coast as the loyal wife of a proud US Marine. She kept the home fires burning, and lovingly raised five children while Sam was often away proudly serving his country. She deserved a medal herself for the strength through adversity. Virginia was co-owner and operator of the Montgomery Ward Catalog Store in Atoka, OK in the early 1970's. Later she partnered with daughter Shani (Kerr) Housewright at K & K Dance Center in Durant in the early 1980's, teaching dance and affecting the lives of many local children in a positive way.
